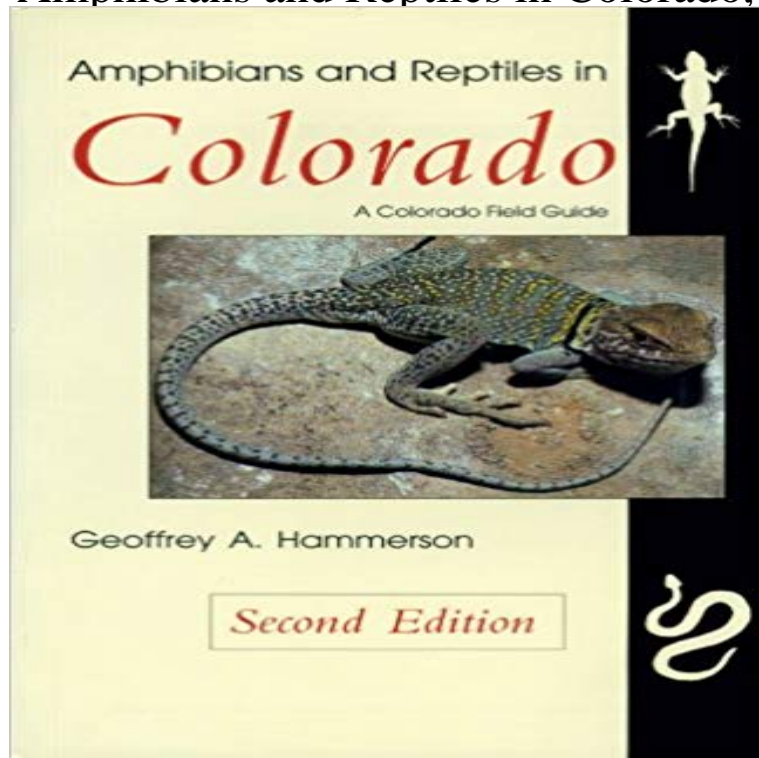


# Amphibians and Reptiles in Colorado, Revised Edition
