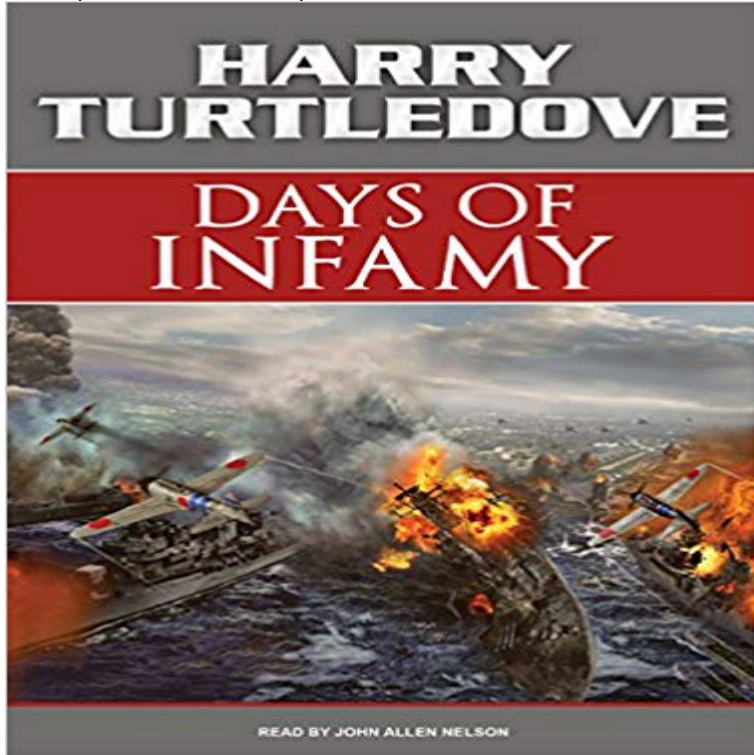


Days of Infamy: A Novel of Alternate History
