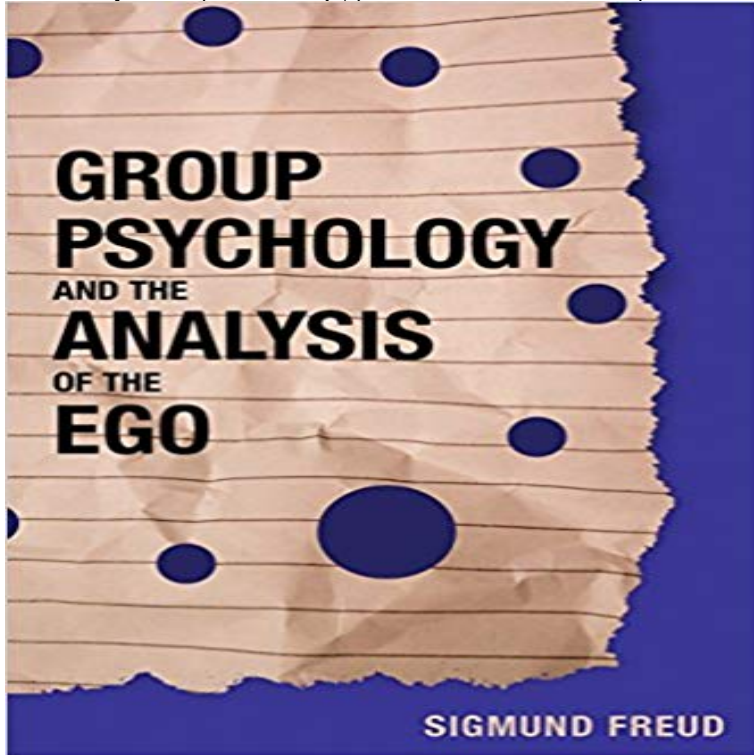


Group Psychology and the Analysis of the Ego
