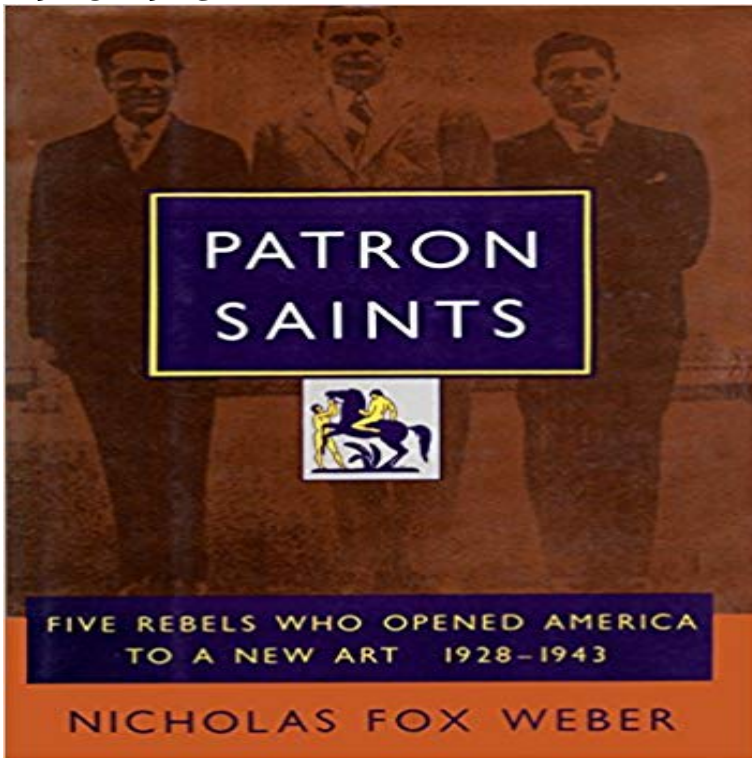


Patron Saints: Five Rebels Who Opened America to a New Art 1928-1943
