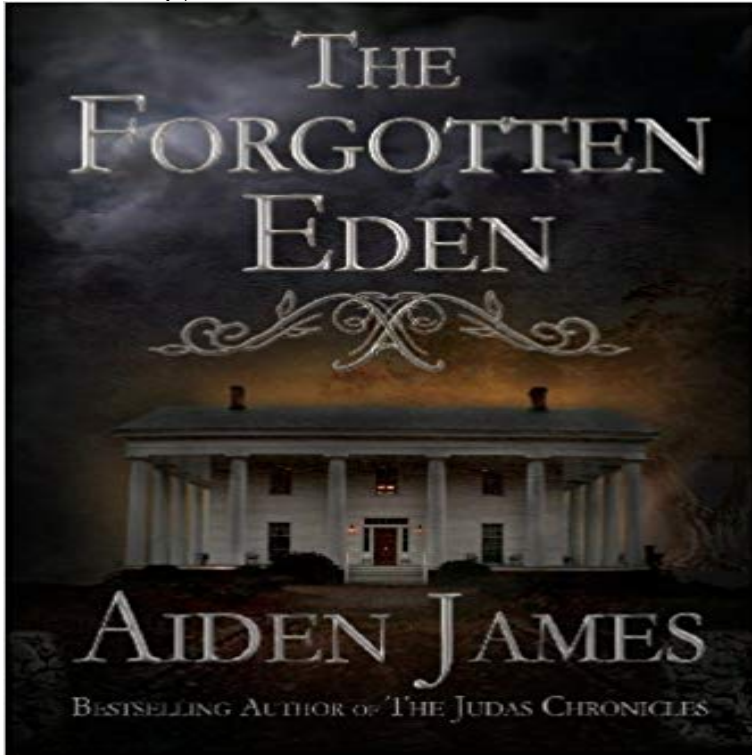


The Forgotten Eden
