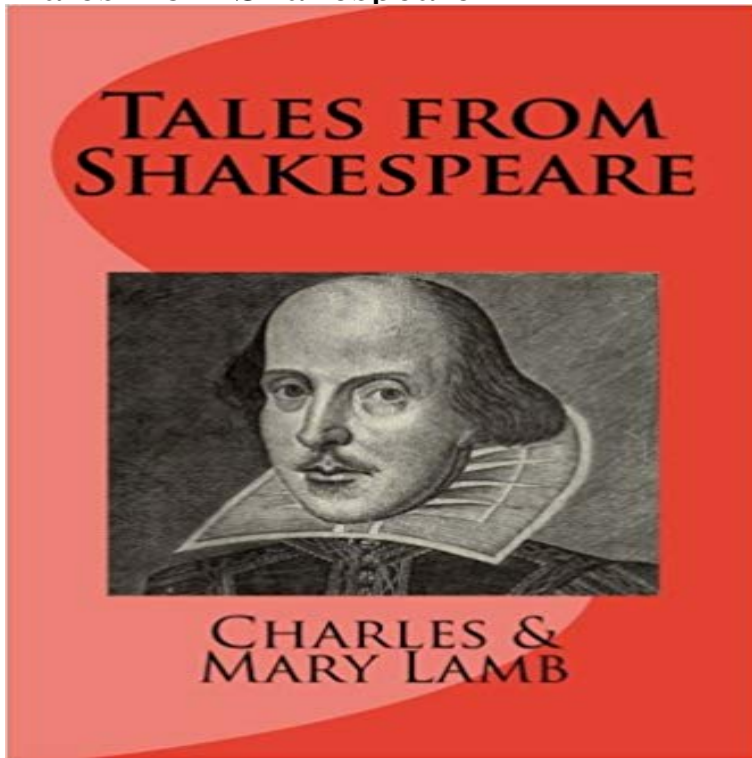


Tales from Shakespeare
