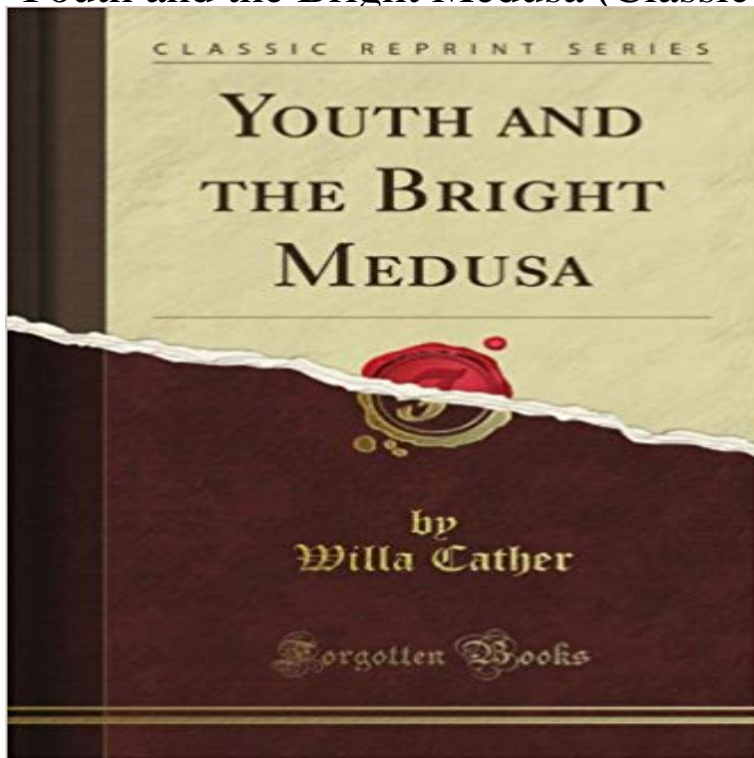


Youth and the Bright Medusa (Classic Reprint)
